



## EMERGENCY GENERATOR REQUIRED LIFE SAFETY SIGN

Monterey Fire Department requires a Life Safety Emergency Sign when a emergency generator is on a commercial and residential property. Emergency generators are required to have a life safety sign so that emergency responders and the public can be easily notified of live electricity even after the main power source is shut down.

A building permit is required from the building department for operating a emergency generator. The emergency generator shall have plans submitted to the building department for review.

The sign must be permanently fixed to a surface. Prior to Fire Department Final for this project, this sign (or approved alternate) must be posted and maintained at one of the following locations:

Main Exterior Electrical Shut Off

Or at a approved location by the AHJ/Fire Official

Below are examples of approved life safety signs.
