Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights  
March 2017

NARRATIVE

- The Monterey Police Department (MPD) conducted a Minor Decoy “Shoulder Tap” Operation. The operation targeted ABC licensed businesses and utilized underage decoys working with direct supervision by Monterey Police Officers. Two individuals were cited for 25658(a) B&P, furnishing alcohol to people under the age of 21. Overtime costs for this operation were reimbursed with Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control grant funds.
- The MPD was assisted by the Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team and the US Marshals Service in identifying, locating and apprehending the suspect in the shooting homicide that occurred on Cannery Row in November 2016.
- The PRVNT was assisted by the Monterey PD, California Highway Patrol, Marina PD, the Multi-Agency Detail for Commercial Auto Theft (MADCAT), and the District Attorney’s Office Investigators on a search warrant service in North Monterey County. Illegal controlled substances, two guns (one stolen), ammunition, several stolen vehicles and cash were seized and a suspect was arrested and booked.
- A suspect was identified and arrested for a serious felony hit and run collision, due to a thorough investigation conducted by a Monterey Police Officer.
- A suspect was arrested after a short foot pursuit, for possession of a stolen vehicle out of the state of Washington, after a routine traffic stop for vehicle code violations.
- Staffing
  - Staffing continues to be a priority for the MPD. The MPD consistently has between 10-20% of the sworn workforce not fully functioning (injured, ill, training, vacation). Fifty-one sworn is the number that should be fully functional, an increase of 10-20% (5-10 additional sworn officers) would account for personnel that are not fully functional.
  - Sworn (as of 03/31/17)
    - 51 authorized (-3 unfilled / -4 extended leave / -2 training / -3 academy - 24%)
  - Non-Sworn (as of 03/31/17)
    - 19 authorized (-1 CSO / -1 AAll extended leave – 11%)

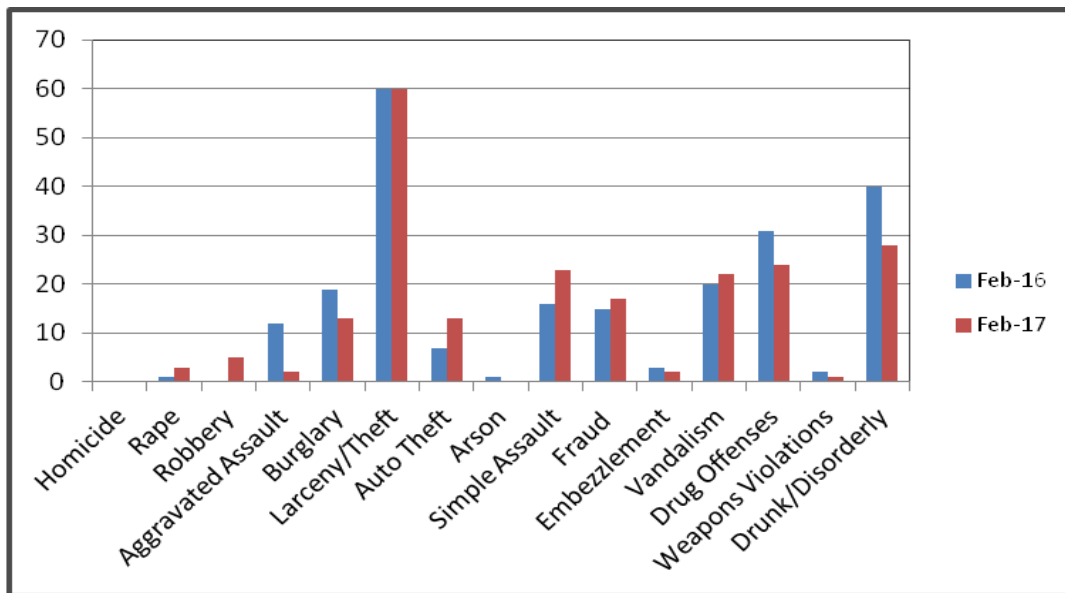


Table B – 2016 Monthly Average v. February 2017
