

Report to City Manager
Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
May 2017

NARRATIVE

- The MPD conducted a minor decoy, “Shoulder Tap” operation which targeted adults who purchase alcohol for underage individuals. Two individuals were cited for furnishing alcohol to people under the age of 21. The overtime costs incurred for this are reimbursed with Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control grant funds.
- The Community Action Team (CAT) hosted ‘Coffee with a Cop’ and outreached to the community.
- PRVNT identified and arrested a suspect wanted for Criminal Threats and Brandishing a Firearm while on Highway 1 between Marina and Seaside.
- MPD Detectives and PRVNT arrested a suspect in connection with armed robberies at the West Garage in Monterey and at the Walgreens in Seaside.
- MPD, PRVNT and Seaside PD investigated an armed robbery that occurred in Monterey. The investigation led to an arrest and the property was recovered.
- MPD Proactive Specified Foot Patrol – May 2017 (does not include calls-for-service)
 - Alvarado Street (225) Foot Patrols
 - Cannery Row (65) Foot Patrols
 - Wharf 1 (82) Foot Patrols
 - Transit Plaza (48) Foot Patrols
- Special Events
 - Cali Roots – May 26, 2017 to May 28, 2017 – Fairgrounds
 - Friday, 5/26/17 – (9) Officers worked a total of 85.75 hours. Approximately 10,000 people in attendance. Three arrests: (1) naked man who was hallucinating and taken to the hospital; (1) for warrants; (1) for public intoxication.
 - Saturday, 5/27/17 – (9) Officers worked a total of 94.25 hours. Approximately 9,000 people in attendance. Three arrests: (1) for fighting in public; (1) for possession of methamphetamine; (1) for public intoxication.
 - Sunday, 5/28/17 – (9) Officers worked a total of 97 hours. Approximately 8,000 people in attendance. Two arrests: (1) for sales of acid and resisting arrest; (1) for possession of narcotics for sale.

 - 51 authorized (-4 unfilled / -3 extended leave / -1 modified duty / -2 training / -3 academy - 25%)
 - Non-Sworn (as of 05/31/17)
 - 19 authorized (-1 AAll extended leave – 5%)

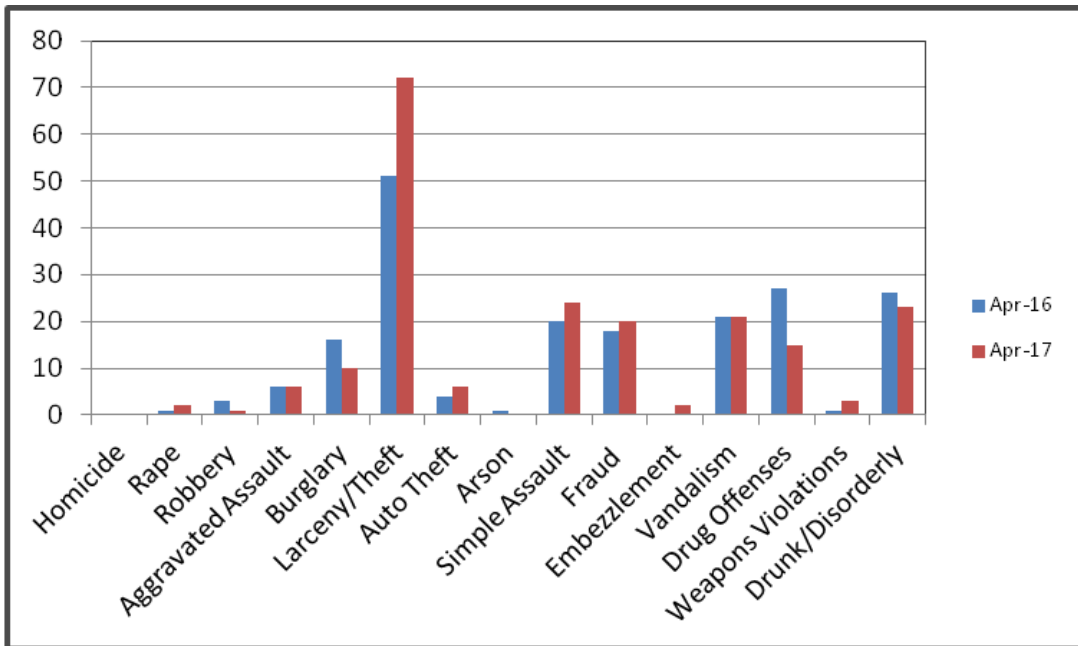


Table B – 2016 Monthly Average v. April 2017
