

Report to City Manager
Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
June 2017

NARRATIVE

- The MPD conducted random visits of eight local Alcoholic Beverage Control licensed establishments in June, which resulted in the issuance of three administrative warning citations for violations noted during inspections in May. The project is part of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control's Education and Teen Alcohol Enforcement Program Grant and is funded by the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
- The Community Action Team (CAT) continues to host 'Coffee with a Cop' at various locations in Monterey. The most recent was on June 23 at Peet's Coffee and Tea at 560 Munras Avenue.
- A CAT officer attended the Casanova Oak Knoll Association (CONA) annual neighborhood meeting on June 28. The 35 CONA members present shared their opinions about oversized and recreational vehicle parking on city streets.

Table A – May 2016 v. May 2017

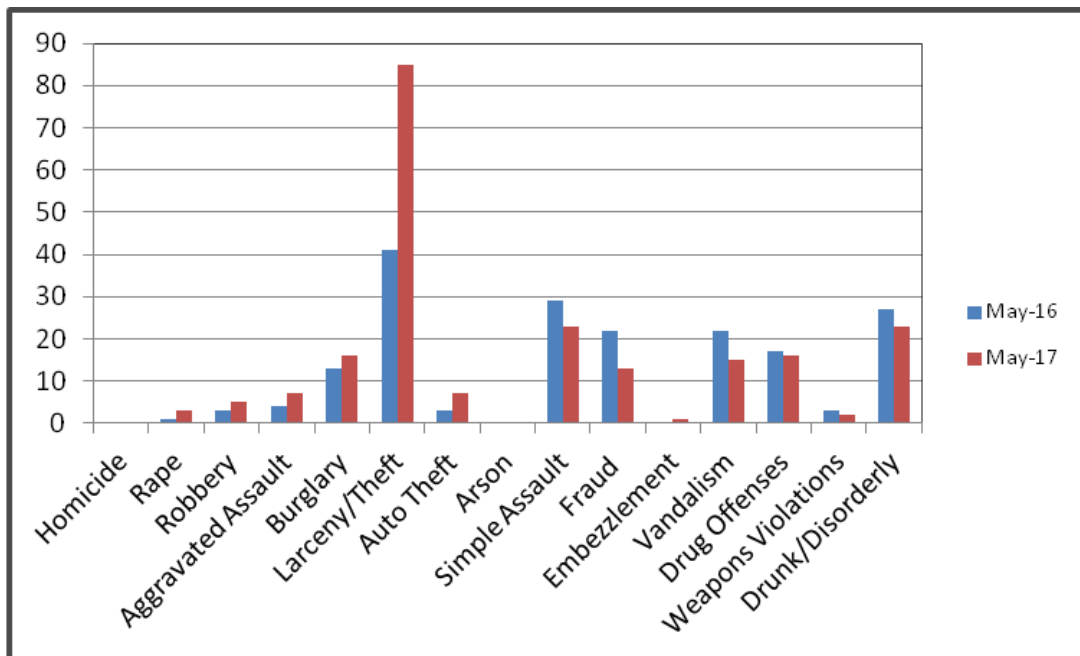


Table B – 2016 Monthly Average v. May 2017
