Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
November 2017

NARRATIVE

- On November 15, 2017, 25 community members and business owners completed the 11-week MPD Citizen's Police Academy, wherein the graduates attended three hour blocks of information a week, related to the services the MPD provides.
- The Monterey Police Department is continuing the Active Shooter Awareness outreach which started in 2015 with the "Run/Hide/Fight" video link on the MPD website that was sent to all City Employees. The MPD has developed a 45 minute presentation for City of Monterey employees and community groups (business groups, churches, etc.). During November, the MPD provided the following Active Shooter awareness outreach:

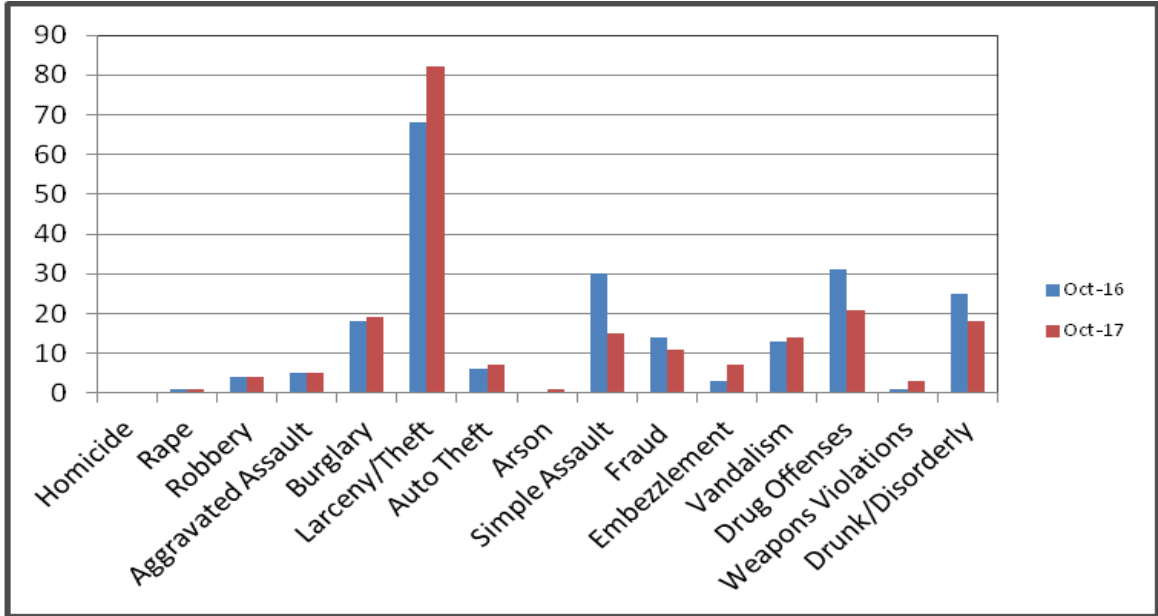


Table B – 2016 Monthly Average v. October 2017
