Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
February 2018

NARRATIVE

- The Junior Police Club at Walter Colton School held its inaugural meeting. Special Response Unit (SRU) members met with the club members to talk about how the SRU utilizes equipment and tactics. The following meeting included the Club learning about crime scene investigations, how a latent shoeprint is cast, and then lifted latent fingerprints.
- MPD Detectives received a tip that a student at Monterey High School posted a message on social media which was potentially a school threat. Detectives worked over the weekend to author and serve a search warrant. The juvenile was contacted and it was determined that the juvenile did not have the intention to threaten anyone.
- Officers responding to a report of an assault with a knife in a wooded area between two homeless individuals. Officers located and arrested the suspect and also resolved a grand theft the suspect was responsible for.
- Officers responded to a theft of a vehicle and started a search for the vehicle. Officers located the stolen vehicle and arrested the suspect.

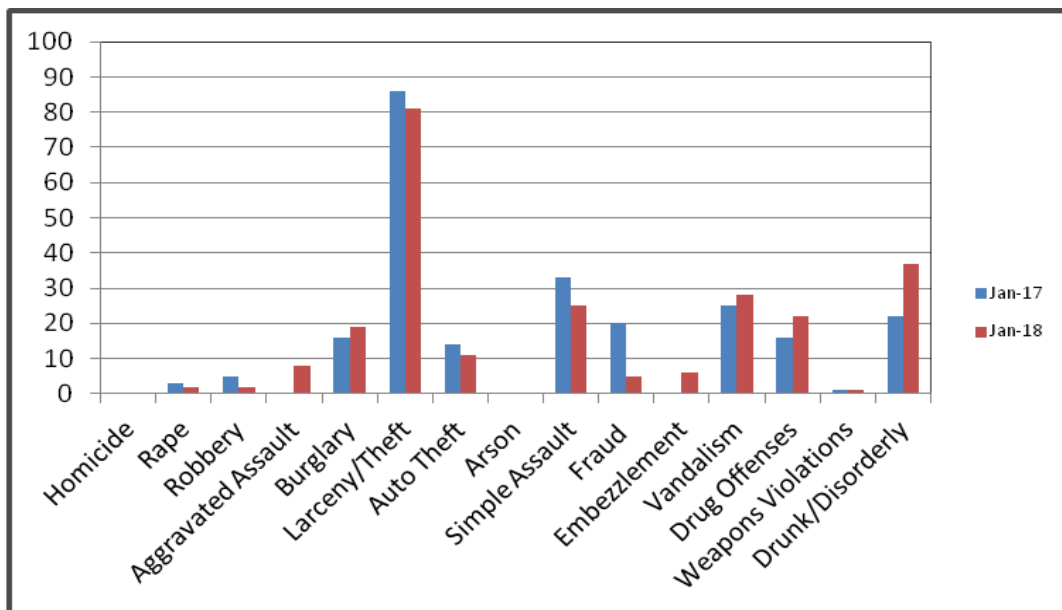


Table B – 2017 Monthly Average v. January 2018
