Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
March 2018

NARRATIVE

- The Community Action Team (CAT) and the School Resource Officer (SRO) provided security for MPUSD students involved in the “Walk Out Wednesday” rally.
- The CAT continues to provide community outreach. CAT presented at the Monterey College of Law Conservatorship Workshop, CAT Participated in the Prescription Drug Summit at the Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, and CAT made multiple visits to the Gathering for Women shelter.
- Investigations and CAT arrested two subjects who committed a home invasion robbery. The suspects are also believed to be responsible for the robbery of an elderly woman at the Del Monte Shopping Center.
- MPD Investigations and CAT assisted the Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team with the arrest of three suspects who were responsible for multiple property crimes throughout the county. A stolen vehicle and five stolen firearms were recovered.

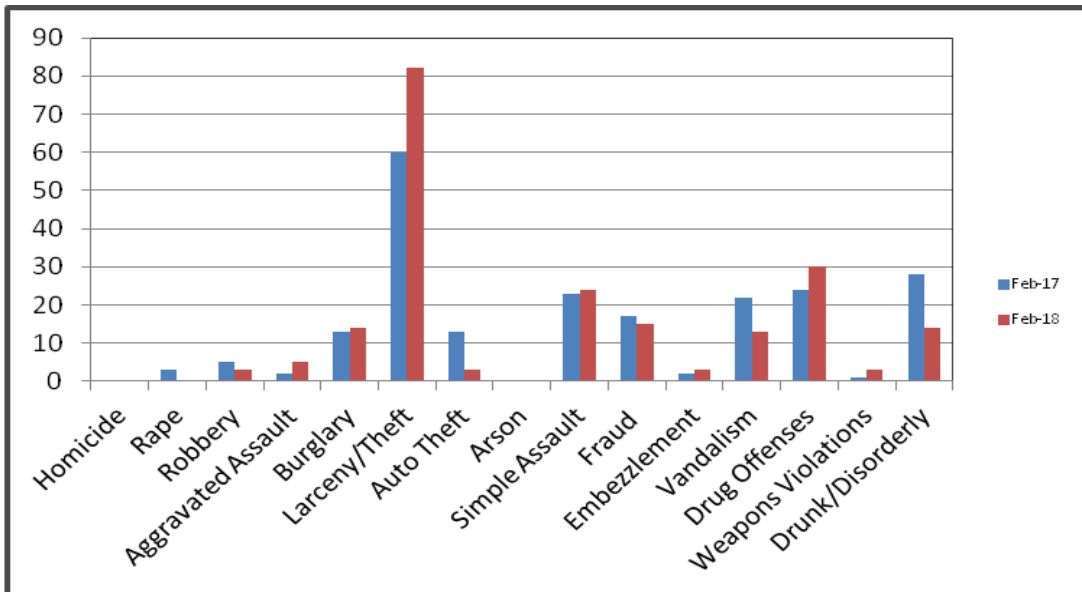


Table B – 2017 Monthly Average v. February 2018
