

Report to City Manager
Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
June 2018

NARRATIVE

- The MPD provided active shooter presentations to hotel employees and security staff at the Monterey Plaza Hotel and at the Monterey Rotary Club.
- A Community Action Team officer gave a public safety presentation at College Living Experience in Monterey.
- Monterey police officers utilized recent Integrating Communications, Assessment, and Tactics (ICAT) training when responding to a report of a mentally unstable person on Alvarado Street. The officers were able to take the person into custody without incident. ICAT training provides police officers options to defuse a range of critical incidents.
- An MPD officer saved a person's life after he was dispatched to a local establishment when it was reported that a person had collapsed on the dance floor. The officer provided CPR until the patient was transported to the Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula (CHOMP) by paramedics.
- Nine MPD officers provided police services at 'Race Night on Cannery Row' on June 23.
- The MPD School Resource Officer gave a presentation at the Ryan Ranch Children's Center.
- Monterey Police sworn and non-sworn employees participated in the Special Olympics Torch Run and the Tip-A-Cop fundraiser. Over \$1,000 was raised to benefit the Special Olympics.
- The Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team (PRVNT) assisted the Carmel and Soledad Police Departments with a search warrant at two residences in Soledad. Officers recovered stolen property, approximately 60 lbs of processed marijuana, a butane honey oil lab used to convert marijuana into concentrated cannabis, and a motorcycle that was reported stolen out of Monterey.

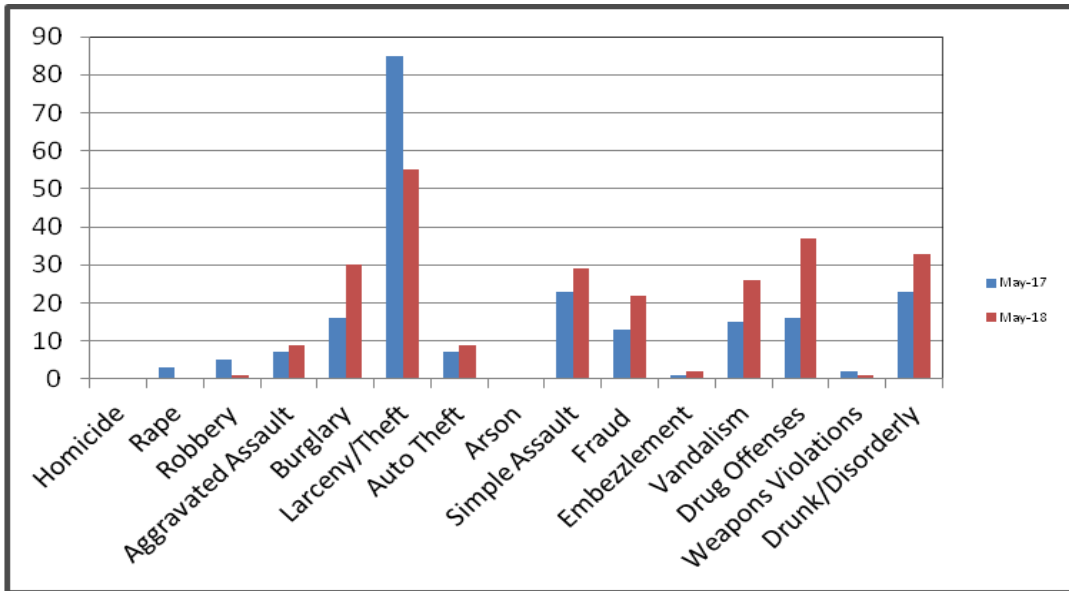


Table B – 2017 Monthly Average v. May 2018
