

Report to City Manager
Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
July 2018

NARRATIVE

- MPD Traffic Officers continue to enhance traffic calming in Monterey and were featured on the front page of the Monterey Herald on July 15, 2018. The Traffic Program was reintroduced in January 2018.
- The Community Services Officers gave a safety presentation at Whispering Pines Day Camp.
- The Community Action Team (CAT) completed thirty encampment cleanups in July. This included twenty camps abated at Del Monte Beach and a sweep of the Old Capital site.
- The CAT continues to provide community outreach through their monthly meetings and station tours. Three groups toured the police facility in July.
- Monterey officers provided public safety services at the 4th of July Parade, the Festa Divino Espirito Santo (FDES) Parade, and the Beer Fest.
- A MPD Detective identified a Bay Area burglary ring that stole thousands of dollars of merchandise from the Lulu Lemon store at the Del Monte Shopping Center.
- A MPD Detective arrested a sexual assault suspect who committed sexual assault while out on bail for a previous sexual assault.
- On July 2, 2018, a Police Services Technician (PST) heard a radio call of a woman who was calling in to relate that she had escaped a kidnapping from Hollister and was somewhere in Monterey. The PST had earlier seen a flier listing the kidnap victim and related this information to the responding officers who were able to locate the kidnapping victim and bring her to safety.
- On July 6, 2018, a MPD Patrol Officer investigated a case regarding a prowler who was harassing an ex-girlfriend. The Officer utilized video camera evidence to prove who the suspect was and after the arrest the suspect made incriminating statements.
- The Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team (PRVNT) arrested four subjects involved in the sales of methamphetamine and heroin on the Peninsula.

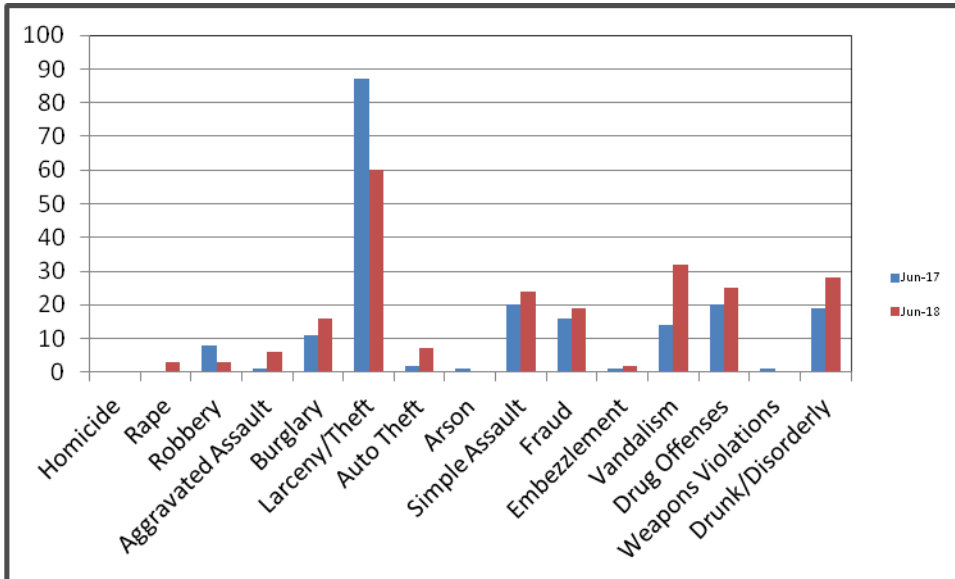


Table B – 2017 Monthly Average v. June 2018
