Narrative

- The Monterey School Resource
 Officer (SRO) gave a presentation at
 the Monterey Institute of International
 Studies to welcome new international
 students to Monterey and share
 crime prevention tips.
- The SRO assisted Monterey High and Monte Vista schools with active shooter drills.
- Two separate social media threats of violence against a school were investigated.
- The Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team arrested suspects in Seaside and in Monterey for possession of narcotics for sales.
- The Community Action Team (CAT)
 assisted the Monterey Domestic
 Violence Advocate in locating a
 homeless domestic violence victim
 from Georgia. The victim may be
 eligible for housing and the process
 for placement has been initiated.

Narrative Cont...

- The CAT assisted at the Monterey County Fair, the Monterey 250 unveiling, the Emergency Preparedness Fair at Del Monte Center, the Jazz Festival, the Santa Rosalia Parade and Monterey Park(ing) Day.
- Officers responded to a shots fired call. The SRO notified a nearby school which went on lockdown while other officers took up fixed points to keep traffic and parents from the danger zone. After 45 minutes of negotiation, officers were able to convince the suspect to surrender peacefully. A search of the residence led to the seizure of multiple guns, evidence of the shooting, and the suspect's arrest. Several citizens and school staff commended the School Resource Officer and the Monterey Police Department for their timely and professional response.




Table A - August 2017 v. August 2018




Table B - 2017 Monthly Average v. August 2018
