### Narrative

#### Monterey School Resource Officer (SRO)

- The SRO attended morning drop-offs at different schools every day to greet students, parents, and staff.

#### Community Action Team

- CAT partnered with Monterey County Adult Protective Services for a presentation about Monterey's Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team at the National Adult Protective Services Association's 30th Annual Conference in Denver, Colorado.
- CAT abated (16) encampments and provided information to the campers regarding services available to the homeless.
- The Community Services Officers provided one station tour and gave a safety presentation to students at Shoreline Church.

#### Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team (MDOT)

- Arranged for a local homeless individual to obtain addiction rehabilitation services in San Jose.
- Arranged transportation at the request of a local homeless woman to be with her family on the east coast.

#### Investigations

- MPD detectives identified two suspects responsible for a commercial burglary of lottery tickets.
- MPD detectives identified a subject who was leaving threatening notes throughout the Monterey Peninsula.
- MPD detectives, CAT and Monterey patrol officers investigated a subject who was making threats to harm his coworkers and law enforcement. Detectives arrested the subject and worked with the DA to ensure he received mental health treatment and was prohibited from possessing firearms.

#### Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team (PRVNT)

- Made the following arrests
  - possession of methamphetamine for sales.
  - possession of cocaine for sales.
  - possession of a concealed loaded firearm and marijuana for sales




Table A – July 2018 v. July 2019




Table B – 2018 Monthly Average v. July 2019
