## **Narrative**

 Patrol responded to a vehicle that drove off the wharf and into the ocean. Patrol coordinated rescue efforts with Fire, Coast Guard, Harbor and AMR.

#### **Community Action Team**

- CAT hosted Coffee with a Cop at Café Lumiere.
- CAT hosted the monthly Homeless Exchange meeting
- CAT conducted two Police station tours
- A CAT investigation led to the arrest of a suspect and the recovery of a dog stolen from the SPCA.
- CAT officers assisted an individual with dementia enroll in Project Lifesaver. Project Lifesaver is a community based non-profit that provides public safety and caregivers with a program to protect and locate people with cognitive disorders.

#### **Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team (MDOT)**

- The CAT and MDOT were successful in finding resources for a homeless family, which included an eight month old infant and an eighteen month old toddler, from camping in Laguna Grande Park into a hotel.
- The CAT and MDOT were successful in gaining resources for a local homeless man into the Genesis House. Genesis House is a substance abuse treatment facility.

#### School Resource Officer

- The SRO participated in an outreach program at Colton School on the last day of school.
   Students had the opportunity to try on different police safety gear, sit on a policy motorcycle and sit in the driver's seat of a patrol vehicle.
- The SRO attended a meeting with Sun Street Center and Monterey High School administration to discuss adding drug counselors on campus.

#### Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team (PRVNT)

 PRVNT and a Monterey Police Detective assisted in the arrest of a suspect with an outstanding warrant from Atascadero. The suspect was located in Monterey in a stolen vehicle and in possession of methamphetamines. The suspect was transported to San Luis Obispo County by Atascadero PD detectives.




Table A - May 2018 v. May 2019




Table B - 2018 Monthly Average v. May 2019
