Narrative

Patrol

- MPD Officers assisted with providing security for the Jazz Festival.
- Patrol Officers made a traffic stop on a vehicle in downtown Monterey and arrested the two occupants for possessing burglary tools, items of identity theft, and a handgun.
- A patrol officer observed a wanted felon outside of a residence in Monterey however the subject went inside. A subsequent search of the residence resulted in locating the subject as well as four other people who were arrested for warrants and/or narcotics violations.

Community Action Team

- CAT participated in the National Park(ing) Day on Alvarado Street.
- CAT abated (36) encampments and provided information to the campers regarding services available to the homeless. Twenty-five camps abated were along the Recreation Trail / Windows on the Bay / Del Monte Beach.
- The Community Services Officers provided one station tour and staffed a booth at the Emergency Preparedness Fair at Del Monte Shopping Center.
- CAT officers spent (26) hours covering patrol assignments.

Monterey School Resource Officer (SRO)

- The SRO presented the "Be Bully Free" workshop to 4th and 5th grade students at Foothill and La Mesa Schools.
- The SRO assisted Monterey High School with an Active Shooter drill.
- The SRO sat on a panel of experts for a CHOMP Town Hall meeting regarding student drug use.
- In light of recent vehicle versus pedestrian vehicle collisions, the SRO worked with Monterey High School administration to remind students of traffic safety during school announcements and through flyer distribution on campus.
- The MPD received numerous complaints from MPUSD parents requesting traffic enforcement around Monterey Schools. During the month of September, MPD issued citations as follows:

◦ Monterey High School –	33 citations
◦ Walter Colton Middle –	1 citation
◦ Foothill Elementary –	2 citations
◦ Monte Vista Elementary –	1 citation
◦ Trinity Christian –	12 citations
◦ Bayview Academy –	5 citations

Investigations

- The Detective Sergeant conducted separate Active Shooter trainings for Jazz Festival staff, AT&T Language Line staff, Monterey Conference Center staff, as well as various businesses at the McGraw Hill building at 20 Ryan Ranch.

Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team (MDOT)

- MDOT arranged for a well-known local homeless individual to obtain residential addiction rehabilitation services at Sun Street.
- MDOT assisted (2) stranded homeless people who wanted to return to Santa Barbara. MDOT gave a presentation at CSUMB about the work MDOT does.

Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team (PRVNT)

- PRVNT & MPD detectives assisted in the attempted murder (stabbing) that took place outside a Monterey nightclub, which was the location of an “after-party” for an event held earlier in the city of Seaside.
- Members of PRVNT provided security for the Monterey County Fair and Jazz Festival.
- PRVNT conducted a probation search in Pacific Grove that resulted in the seizure of MDMA (ecstasy) and possession of marijuana for sales.
- During the service of a search warrant, PRVNT recovered (5) firearms as well as marijuana for sales and an illegal alcohol still.
