Narrative

Patrol

- A subject stole a car and MPD officers located him hiding in the woods on Iris Canyon Road. MPD arrested the suspect and returned the vehicle to the owner.
- An MPD officer located a loaded assault rifle, cocaine and methamphetamine in a car after conducting a traffic stop and learning the suspect had a warrant for his arrest.

Community Action Team

- CAT met with the Golden Oaks Neighborhood Association.
- CAT abated (40) illegal encampments while providing service information to those who they contacted. Seventeen illegal camps were along Del Monte Beach.
- The Community Service Officers provided one station tour.
- CAT gave a presentation to Monterey Peninsula College staff regarding safety and security.
- CAT personnel assisted in the two week clean-up of the Old Capitol Site.

Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team (MDOT)

- MDOT participated in and gave a presentation at a community homeless awareness event at the Osio Theater.

Monterey School Resource Officer (SRO)

- The SRO gave a presentation regarding illicit drug trends and vaping to parents and staff at Bay View Academy.
- The SRO attended the Bay View Academy "Dia Los Muertos" celebration, interacting with students and handing out anti-bullying themed stickers.
- The SRO conducted an investigation regarding a Monterey High School student selling drugs via social media. The student was found to have Xanax pills at the school and his home, for sale.
- The SRO also investigated a report of a student who was selling marijuana on social media. The student was found to have a half pound of marijuana, (43) marijuana vaping cartridges and a large amount of cash.

Investigations

- MPD detectives investigated and arrested a suspect that committed multiple burglaries at sunglasses stores.
- Detectives investigated and arrested a suspect involved in a road rage incident that spanned from Highway 1 and throughout Monterey.

**Peninsula Regional Violence
and Narcotics Team (PRVNT)**

- PRVNT detectives arrested three suspects in Monterey for operating a drug house and using narcotics.
- PRVNT detectives arrested a subject for possession of over (700) counterfeit Xanax pills.
- PRVNT detectives assisted in the arrest of five suspects, seizure of a loaded handgun and the recovery of a stolen computer after the suspects robbed patrons of their laptops at Starbucks in Monterey and Pacific Grove. The suspects led officers on a high-speed pursuit from Monterey to Gilroy, where the suspects finally surrendered after the California Highway Patrol disabled their car.
- PRVNT investigated a case, which resulted in the District Attorney charging a 17 years-old suspect with involuntary manslaughter for supplying fentanyl to a 16 years-old female which caused her death after an overdose.
- PRVNT investigated another fentanyl case, which resulted in the DA charging a subject with selling fentanyl, which resulted in their death after an overdose.
