
# **MONTHLY REPORT**

#### MONTEREY POLICE DEPARTMENT



## **Narrative**

- A Monterey officer performed CPR on an unconscious elderly woman, reviving her.
- Monterey officers took four organized retail theft suspects into custody after coordinating a perimeter at the Del Monte Shopping Center.
   The suspects were from Fresno.
- A Monterey police officer identified and arrested two subjects for possession of burglary tools, stolen property and identify theft. The stolen property linked the suspect to a recent stolen vehicle and two residential burglaries.
- A Monterey PD investigation led to the identification and apprehension of a Salinas robbery suspect.

#### **School Resource Officer**

- Gave a presentation about the Constitution to (3) twelfth grade civics classes at Monterey High School.
- During "Read Across America Day" the SRO, CSOs and a Monterey Police Services Technician read to (8) classes at Monte Vista School
- The SRO facilitated a discussion with a State Park lifeguard who talked about his duties, discussed water safety, and showed the kids his truck and Jet Ski for the Junior Police Club at Colton School.

#### **Community Action Team**

- Organized a Coffee with a Cop event at the Captain & Stoker coffee shop
- Facilitated the monthly Monterey Homeless Exchange meeting
- Community Services Officers provided a safety presentation at Hilltop Park.
- The CSOs conducted two station tours.

#### **Multi-Disciplinary Outreach Team (MDOT)**

- Assisted in connecting Domestic Violence advocates with a crime victim
- Worked with a Monterey County mental health crisis worker to coordinate and obtain regular Monterey County Behavioral Health services for a Monterey resident who was experiencing emotional issues.
- Assisted a local homeless resident by providing him blankets, clothing and dog food for his dog.
- Visited a local homeless resident at the Monterey County Jail and was able to schedule the subject a placement assessment for housing when released.

#### Peninsula Regional Violence and Narcotics Team

- Assisted the Presidio of Monterey Police Department with a homicide and arson investigation. The suspect was arrested in San Jose and confessed.
- Arrested two males in Seaside for possession of methamphetamine for sales, recovering over four ounces of methamphetamine.
- Arrested a subject driving a stolen vehicle who had previously been involved in a pursuit on the Peninsula while driving another stolen vehicle.




Table A - February 2018 v. February 2019





Table B – 2018 Monthly Average v. February 2019
