



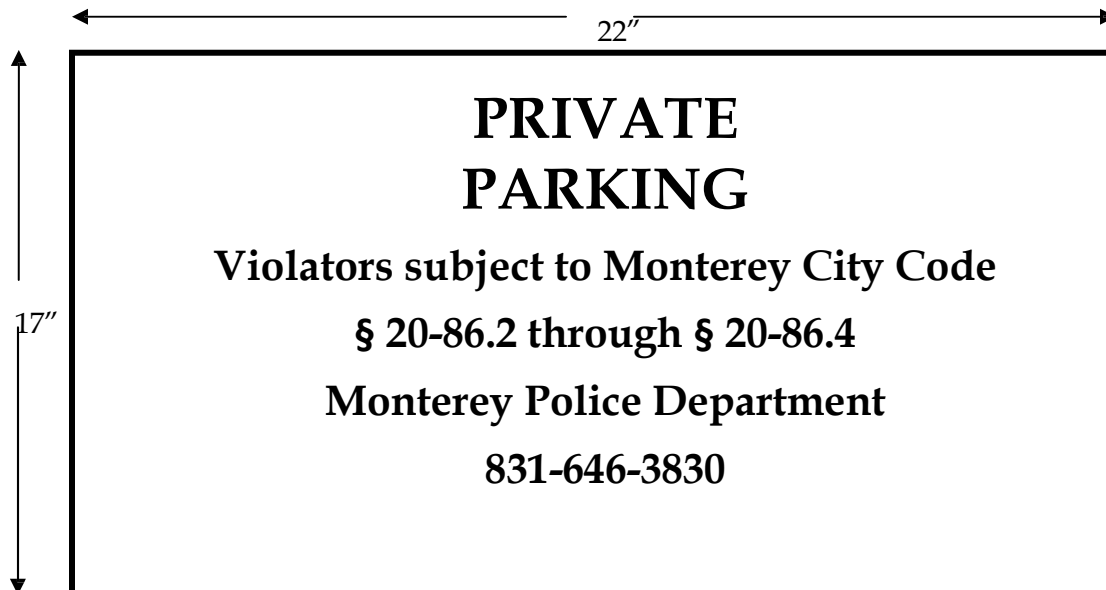

Dear Property Owner:

In order to adequately prevent the abuse of parking rights on private property, the City of Monterey enacted Monterey City Code §20-86.2 thru §20-86.4 which gives the Monterey Police Department authority to enforce unauthorized parking violations on private property.

In order to allow for this enforcement, the property owner must post a sign, preferable made of fused porcelain ceramic enamel or equivalent, at each vehicular entrance. The sign must measure no less than 17"x22" with lettering at least 1" high and contain the following wording:



Signs should be posted on posts, walls, or other appropriate surfaces using weather-resistant fasteners and hardware. Care should be taken to ensure the sign is visible, not obscured by foliage or other obstructions as this could preclude the enforcement of parking violations on your property. Damaged or faded signs should be promptly replaced to maintain the continuity of enforcement.
