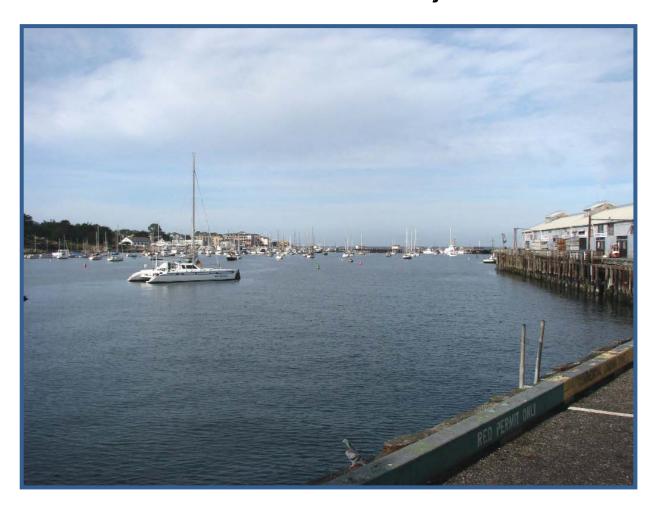

Capital Improvement Program Funding:

The total proposed funding level for the FY 2010/2011 CIP Program is \$2,147,400. This funding is for 12 CIP projects.

\$750,000 of this amount is for traffic/street improvements and rehabilitation.

\$360,400 is for repair and maintenance of public utilities, namely the City sewer system.

\$242,000 is for parking or parking-related projects. \$117,000 of this amount is to update the 1994 ADA transition plan and for analysis of ADA deficiencies at various City parking lots.

\$795,000 is for maintenance.

Neighborhood Improvement Program Funding:

Due to the ongoing budget crisis, at their January 14, 2010, meeting, the NIP Committee unanimously passed a recommendation to City Council to put the FY 2010/11 NIP cycle on hold and use the NIP funds towards balancing the FY2009/10 and FY 2010/11 budget.

On February 2, 2010, City Council adopted Resolution No. 10-008 C.S., approving the transfer of the Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP) funds for FY2010/2011 to the General Fund for ordinary and necessary services. This decision effectively stopped the NIP from going forward this year.

At their February 25, 2010 meeting, the NIP Committee approved stopping the FY2010/2011 NIP process as of that meeting and resuming the program in January 2011. They also approved carrying forward all qualified proposals to the next fiscal year for discussion and consideration. Proposals for new projects will continue to be accepted throughout the year for consideration in 2011, but no nomination forms will be mailed to City residents.

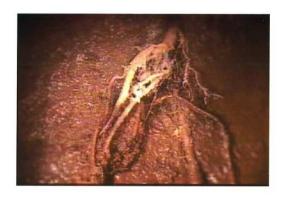
FRACTURE - MULTIPLE (FM)



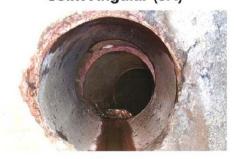
Surface Damage - Missing Wall (SMW)

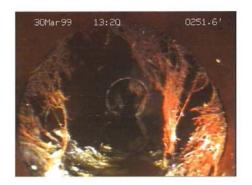

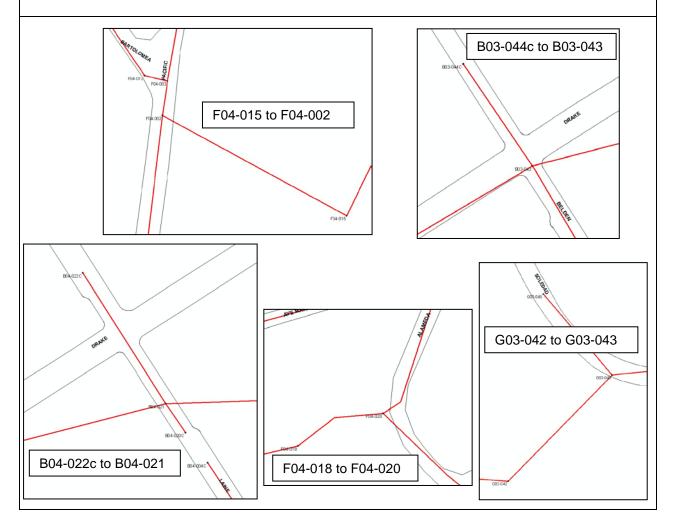
