## CITY UNVEILS VIRTUAL BIKE RACK LOCATOR MAP

Monterey, CA. – In pursuit of continuing to improve alternative transportation infrastructure throughout Monterey, the City of Monterey boasts a number of bicycle rack locations to encourage use of bicycles as a prime means of commuting. Newly created maps show the locations of these bicycle racks to conveniently park and secure bikes. The maps are both printable at [www.monterey.org/bicycles](http://www.monterey.org/bicycles) and on a Google-type interactive map layer within the Property Review map linked from the City’s Geographic Information Systems (GIS) web page at [www.monterey.org/gis](http://www.monterey.org/gis).

Businesses are encouraged to contact Senior Associate Planner Fernanda Roveri to add their bicycle parking facilities to the inventory listing. Take a photo of the bike rack and email it to [roveri@monterey.org](mailto:roveri@monterey.org) with a description of its location and address.

In October 2019, Monterey became an official part of a national network of bike paths that runs from San Diego to Seattle. The resolution passed by the Monterey City Council designates portions of existing trails and streets through the city as part of the [U.S. Bicycle Route 95](#). Route 95 mirrors the Coast Highway. In doing so, the City Council aims to “promote ... the vision to make Monterey a city where alternative forms of transportation are so attractive that the use of an automobile is a choice, not a necessity.”



In addition to bicycle racks, the City also offers bicycle lockers to rent at the Cannery Row Garage at 601 Wave Street and the Downtown East Garage at Washington and Del Monte streets. Lockers can be rented on a monthly (\$15) or quarterly (\$36) basis. Bike lockers are currently booked, but the Parking Division Office manages a waitlist.
