Monterey, CA. – The Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District and the cities of Monterey and Seaside are hosting a virtual town hall meeting on Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the upcoming Laguna Grande Regional Park Master Plan project. Local landscape architects, BFS Landscape Architects, will facilitate the discussion and provide a short presentation outlining the park planning scope, including long-range goals and maintenance to provide the best uses possible for people to enjoy. Regional Park District, City of Monterey, and City of Seaside staff will be on-hand to answer questions, as well.

“Implementation of a cohesive management plan is just beginning, and we encourage residents to participate throughout the process to make the most of what Laguna Grande Regional Park can offer,” said Senior Associate Planner Chris Schmidt.
