

Public Safety and Clean Up – Fireworks Prohibited

The City of Monterey wants everyone to enjoy a safe July 4th. We are in a severe drought and fire risk is high. The Monterey Fire Department reminds everyone that fireworks of any kind,

including 'safe and sane' fireworks, are prohibited in the City of Monterey and carry a significant fine of \$1,000. The Monterey Police Department reminds everyone not to drink alcohol or smoke marijuana and drive. If you intend to drink or smoke, do so responsibly and use ride-sharing services or arrange a designated driver in advance.

The City of Monterey also encourages everyone to help maintain our pristine environment and Monterey Bay by packing up, cleaning up, and putting trash into receptacles. If you are visiting the beach, please bring your own garbage bag/receptacle and take your trash with you. Keep the sea plastic free.
